

## High Country Newfoundland Club Rescue Network

Thank you for your interest in adopting a Newfoundland Dog through our Rescue Program.

We re-home approximately 10-15 Newfoundlands each year. These dogs are either given up by their owners or picked up from shelters. The majority of the Newfoundlands who are adopted through our program are generally between 2 and 5 years old but we do get dogs of all ages. We occasionally get a "senior citizen" who is over 8 years of age needing a retirement home. We seldom get young puppies into the rescue program but, unfortunately, it does happen.

All Newfs placed through rescue are evaluated for temperament, vet-checked, and neutered or spayed (at the appropriate age).

Adoptions are made on a matched basis, based on the background and needs of the Newfoundland and prospective owners. Adoption fees begin at \$350 and help to cover the associated costs of adoptions. The actual cost of each dog depends upon the expenses incurred. Senior dogs are usually placed at a reduced fee, youngsters are usually higher. We include one year of membership in our organization, the High Country Newfoundland Club as well.

Enclosed you will find an application for adoption. Please return the application at your earliest convenience. We keep applications on file for 6 months. If you wish your application to remain current, please contact us. If you obtain a dog from elsewhere or change your mind about getting a Newfoundland through our rescue program, please notify us so that we can remove your application from our current files.
